Sermon: Have you commanded the morning?

Texts: Job 38 verse 12

Bible Passage: 1 Samuel 17 verses 42-50

In 1 Samuel 17 verse 50, the Bible says so David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone and smote the philistine and slew him but there was no sword in the hand of David. The Lesson to learn is that the Lord does not save by sword but by his words, God honours his words as seen in Isaiah 55 verse 11 (so shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth; it shall not return unto me void but it shall accomplish that which I please and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it).

The morning is the beginning of the day, the beginning of life, the beginning of everything, if the morning is polluted, the day is wasted, if the morning is injured, the day is gone, God knew how important the morning is that is why he said in Job 38 verse 12 that have you commanded the morning?

To every morning, there are challenges and attacks of the enemies lying in wait The morning we are talking about is:-

- Your destiny
- Your marriage
- Business
- Ministry
- Your foundation (The Bible says in Psalm 11 verse 3, If the foundation be destroyed what can the righteous do?). Will you allow the enemies to destroy your morning or you will command the morning

## To command the morning is to:

- Take authority over it
- Cast out the enemies
- Destroy the weapons of the enemies
- Take what belongs to you
- Release blessings of the day upon your life
- Tell the enemies to hands off from your life
- Disgrace the plans and activities of the enemies
- Kill and destroy the enemies and adversaries at the door of your breakthrough

Biblical example In 1 Samuel 17 verse 42-50, David knew that the death of the philistine will bring relief and peace to the community. Beloved the stone and sling were not what killed Goliath, it was the word of God that was spoken in 1 Samuel 17 verses 45-47, there is power in your words as seen in Job 22 verse 28 that thou shall also decree a thing and it shall be established unto thee and the light shall shine upon thy ways. Will you decree upon the morning now or allow the enemies to take it over

For you to command the morning and for God to honour your decree you must be a man that understands:

- The Importance of words of God
- The power of prayer
- prophesy
- The ways of the Lord
- Power and the move of God
- The morning

## **Prayers**

- 1. Power to pray without ceasing envelop my life and family in the name of Jesus
- 2. I take authority over the day, it shall work for me in the name of Jesus
- 3. Agenda of the enemies to capture my destiny be wasted now in the name of Jesus
- 4. Power planning to capture my morning fail and die in the name of Jesus
- 5. If the enemies have captured my morning, by the power of the living God I recapture my morning back in the name of Jesus
- 6. Powers holding down my morning release them and die in the name of Jesus
- 7. Fresh fire of the Lord consume all the evil buried in my morning in the name of Jesus
- 8. Lord uproot evil plantations from my morning in the name of Jesus
- 9. Power causing my morning, day and night, lose your power and die in the name of Jesus
- 10. Coven of darkness controlling my morning be consume now by fire in the name of Jesus
- 11. Lord waste the arrows fired at my foundation in the name of Jesus
- 12. Lord set me free from the causes troubling my morning in the name of Jesus
- 13. I refused to allow the enemies control my morning, I withdraw the control of my morning from the hands of the enemies in the name of Jesus
- 14. Fire and thunder of the Lord fall upon those using my morning against me in the name of Jesus
- 15. My morning I command you to bring me blessings and joy always in the name of Jesus
- 16. My Morning I decree you shall connect me with greatness in the name of Jesus
- 17. My morning I decree, vomit out the hands of the enemies and bewitchment in the name of Jesus
- 18. My morning shall not cause me pain in the name of Jesus
- 19. I decree shame and disgrace upon all those throwing arrows at my morning in the name of Jesus
