Text: 1Kings 11 vs. 26-40, 1 Kings 12 vs, 25-33

- 1. Deceitful doctrine Jeremiah 8 vs. 10-12
- 2. Not been sensitive to the voice of the Holy Spirit
- 3. Ignorance of worldliness within the Church Matthew 21 vs. 12-13
- 4. Being carried away by fat offerings Acts 8 vs. 20
- 5. Ignoring the cry of the needy James 1 vs. 27
- 6. Not been sensitive to the voice of Satan Acts 16 vs. 16-18
- 7. Not been sensitive to the devises of darkness Acts 8 vs. 9-11
- 8. Idolatry in the Church Ezekiel 8 vs. 5- 18
