

Message: Touch not my anointed

Text: Psalm 105 verse 15

Bible Reading: Daniel 6 verses 1- end

In Psalm 105 verse 15, the Bible says “saying, touch not mine anointed and do my prophets no harm” it was a clear warning from the Lord to anyone or anything not to touch his anointed ones. God was sounding the warning clearer that if you touch his anointed, you will see his trouble.

Who then are the anointed of God?

- Those who have Jesus as their Lord and personal saviour
- Those who have been baptised with water for repentance and fire (Baptism of the Holy Ghost)
- Those who are obeying God and walking in his ways
- Those who have the blood of Jesus on them
- Those whose names are in the book of life
- Those who are born again
- Those with the spirit of God in them
- They are the apple of God’s eyes
- They are the chosen generations
- The saint of God
- Those who are called by the name of the Lord

Who are those that the Lord is warning not to touch his anointed?

- Principalities and powers
- Spiritual wickedness
- Satan and all his demonic agents
- Sinners
- Enemies of your father’s house
- Those who hates you because you are serving God
- Anyone and anything both in heaven, on earth or beneath the sea

Touch not my anointed means

- Do not speak or cause my choosing ones
- Do not fashion any weapons against them
- Do not cause my children
- Do not plot or dig holes for them
- Do not lay your hands on them for evil
- Do not conspire against them

In Daniel 6 verses 1- end we saw the account of certain people who conspired against the anointed of God and they ended up with their families as food for the Lion

When they try to touch you

- Calamity will befall them
- They will fall into the pit they have dug
- God will arise and fight them
- God will turn them against themselves
- There will be divine substitution (Death)

Haman tried to touch Mordecai, he paid with his life

Ahithophel conspired against David and God made him to commit suicide 2 Samuel 15 verse 31 and 2 Samuel 17 verse 23

Do you know that despite the warning, the anointed can still be-

- touched
- Beaten
- Disgraced
- Imprisoned
- Flogged
- Held captive
- Destroyed
- Killed

Why?

- when the anointed departs from the Lord
- When the anointed is living a life of sin
- No longer regards God and the things of God
- No longer regard God as his source of strength
- When the anointed disobeys the Lord without repentance

What must we do/ Altar call

Prayers

1. Anointing of the Lord that cannot be touched, disgraced or destroyed baptise me in the name of Jesus
2. All those planning to touch me when the Lord says touch not my anointed shall face the judgement of God in the name of Jesus
3. Anointing that is above those of the enemies fall upon me and my family in the name of Jesus
4. Father Lord declare your holy war against all those troubling my peace in the name of Jesus
5. I fight my troublers with the anger of the Lord in the name of Jesus
6. I disgraced and destroyed those power touching my business in the name of Jesus
7. Those touching my family for evil shall die shamefully in the name of Jesus
8. Fire from the Lord waste those touching me with witchcraft in the name of Jesus
9. The coven of witchcraft where deliberation is made on my behalf be scatter to pieces in the name of Jesus
10. Witches and wizards that ignore the warning of touch not my anointed shall die in the pool of their own blood in the name of Jesus
11. Eaters of flesh and drinkers of blood, eat your own flesh and drink your own blood in the name of Jesus

13. I decree woe to all my adversaries in the name of Jesus
14. I decree sudden disaster upon my troublers in the name of Jesus
15. Agenda of the wicked powers of my father's house to waste me be dash to pieces in the name of Jesus
16. Oh Lord build your new edge of fire around me and family in the name of Jesus
17. Anointing of the overcomers fall upon me and my family in the name of Jesus
18. Oh Lord make and turn me to hot coal of fire in the name of Jesus
19. I refused to submit to the threat of the enemies, they shall surrender to me and die before me in the name of Jesus
20. Father Lord I thank you for saving me from the enemies that refused to let me go in the name of Jesus
