**Bible reading: John 1:1-11 KJV** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. [2] The same was in the beginning with God. [3] All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. [4] In him was life; and the life was the light of men. [5] And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. [6] There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. [7] The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe. [8] He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. [9] That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. [10] He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. [11] He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

Jesus Chris according to the scripture above is God that came in human form to save man from darkness. Jesus Christ also died to reconcile us back to God as seen in **Colossians 1:20,22 KJV** And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. **New birth** is to be born again as seen in **John 3:3-7 KJV** Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. [4] Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? [5] Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. [6] That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

**New birth** is the new man of a man in Christ Jesus, it is the evidence of Christ in a life as seen in **2 Corinthians 5:17 KJV** Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. **New birth** is to Crucify the flesh as seen in **Galatians 5:24 KJV** And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

In conclusion, you cannot be called a Christian without Christ in you and you cannot be his ambassador. You are a Christian when Christ is living and ruling the affairs of your life....
